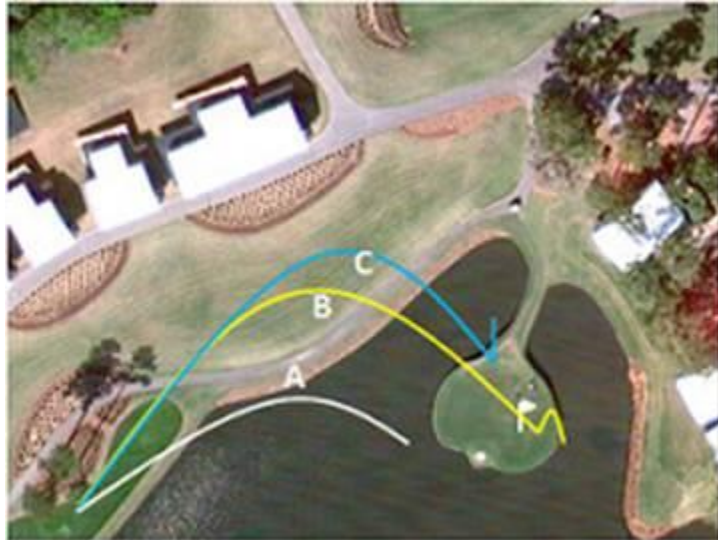

GREENS AND FAIRWAYS

Seeing as we have many water Hazards and water at Chapman an appropriate Rule will hopefully assist our playing members and Guests and eliminate the much asked question “: SO WHERE DO I DROP NOW” ..Relief from Water Hazard (Again)

Let us see if readers remember where to drop their ball when taking relief from a water hazard, which was first covered in previously.



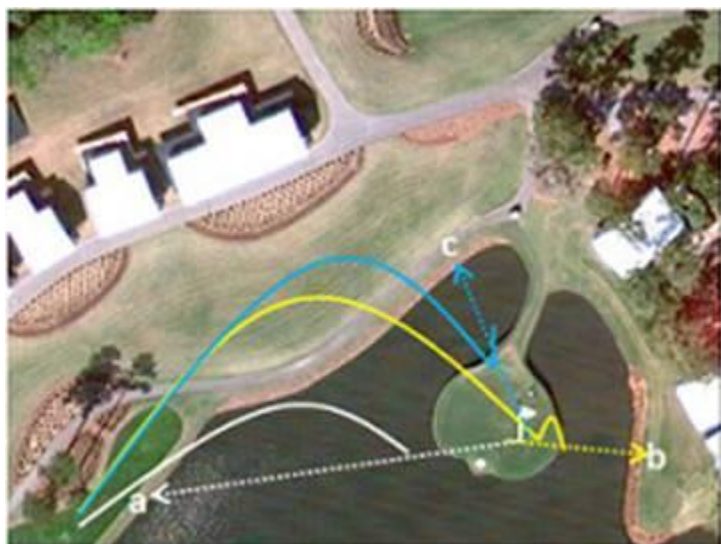
The photo is an aerial view of the famous 17th, island green hole at TPC at Sawgrass. The white (A), yellow (B) and blue (C) lines represent the line of flight for three players' tee shots. The trajectories of the balls are high in the air, but straight between the teeing ground and the putting green. A's ball lands in the water short of the putting green, B's ball bounces past the hole and into the water and C's ball lands on the putting green and spins back into the water. None of the balls can be played from in the water.

Question 1:

Assuming that it is a water hazard defined on all sides by yellow stakes/lines, that there is no relevant Local Rule in operation, no dropping zone and that the player does not choose to play again from the teeing ground; Where must A, B & C drop their balls, under penalty of one stroke?

Answer 1:

In the photo below, each player must drop a ball behind the hazard anywhere on a continuation of the dotted line drawn from the flagstick through where their ball last crossed the margin of the hazard.



Remember that this is a 2-dimensional representation.

The trajectory of each ball is high in the air on a straight line.

Note: In the case of A this option would mean dropping on the 17th tee box, so in reality the player would probably choose to play again from the teeing ground.

Note: Rule 26-1b states that the player may under penalty of one stroke;

Drop a ball behind the water hazard,, keeping the point at which the original ball last crossed the margin of the water hazard directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the water hazard the ball may be dropped

2017 CHAPMAN GRAND SLAM

SPONSORED by DOVES HOLDINGS

The Grand Slam tournament was held from the 8th to the 9th of July 2017, where clubs entered their top players and teams to represent them. This year due to financial constraints being experienced at most clubs we saw only 8 clubs entering this event Royal Golf Club, Country Club, Wingate Golf Club, Hippo Valley Golf Club, Triangle Golf Club, Warren Hills, Sherwood Golf Club and the hosts Chapman.

There were over 70 players that participated in the two-day tournament which was played over 54 holes, 36 holes were played on Saturday and 18 holes on Sunday morning.

The prize giving for this tournament was well attended by more than 150 people who included family and friends of the participants, delegates from the ZGA board, Chapman board members and not forgetting our Grand Slam Sponsors, Doves Holdings representatives. This year's winner was Zimbabwe's top amateur ranked in the top six in the world Sean Croker who is on a golf scholarship in the United States of America and playing off a handicap of +5. He shot a 9 under par 207 gross over the three rounds winning by over 18 shots to second placed Chapman Club Champion David Amm who shot 7 over on a score of 223. Our Chapman team also won the team competition which consisted of Tafadzwa Nyamukondiwa, Jack Allard, Stuart Krog and David Amm.

This year's event was a huge success and we thank our sponsors Doves Holdings for coming on board and that will attract more participants next year.
