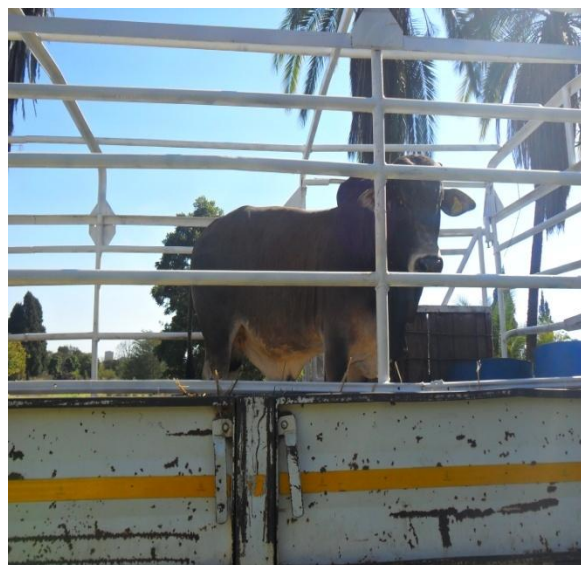

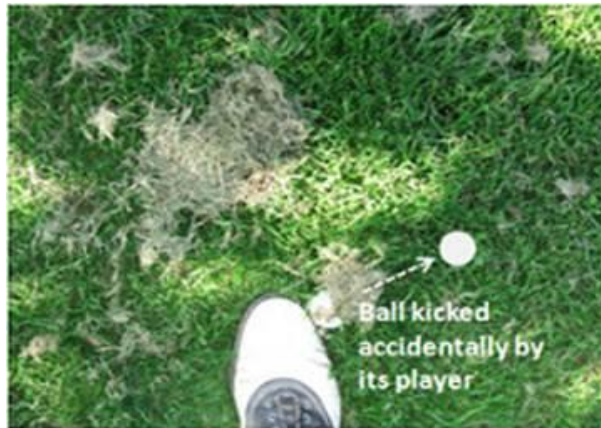

No.32 Moving a Ball During Search



Question 1:

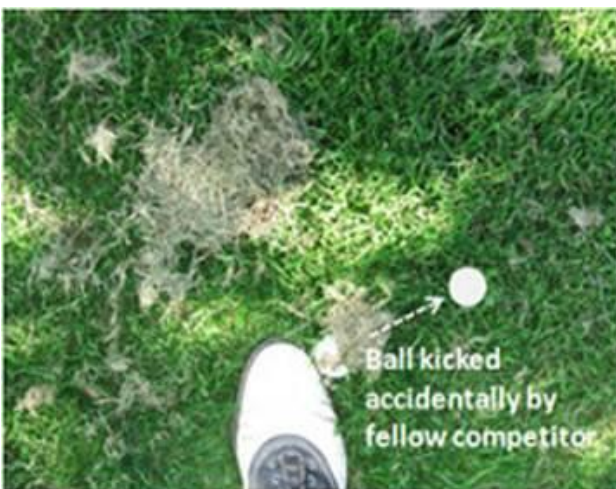
What is the penalty if a player accidentally causes their ball to move while searching for it through the green?

Answer 1:

The player incurs a one stroke penalty and the ball must be replaced. Rule 18-2.

Note: Rule 12-1, as amended on 1st January 2012, states that there is no penalty if a player accidentally causes their ball to move....;

- in searching for a ball covered by sand anywhere on the course,
- in the replacement of loose impediments moved in a hazard while finding or identifying a ball,
- in probing for a ball lying in water in a water hazard,
- In searching for a ball in an obstruction or an abnormal ground condition.



Question 2:

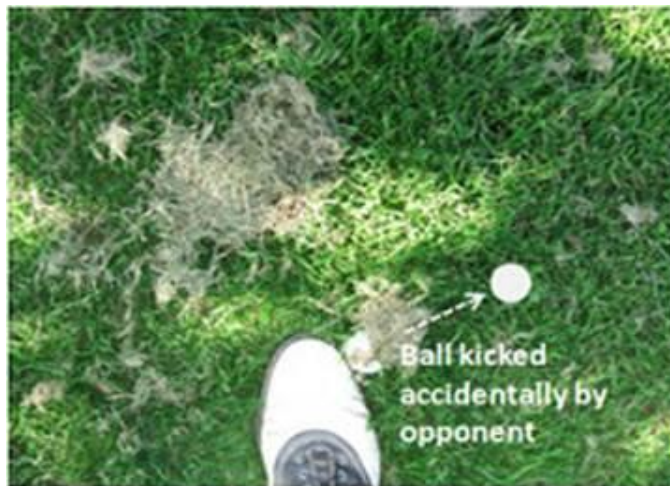
In stroke play, what is the penalty if a player **accidentally** moves a fellow competitor's ball while searching for it through the green?

Question 3:

In stroke play, what is the penalty if a player **purposely** moves a fellow competitor's ball while searching for it through the green?

Answer 2 and Answer 3:

In stroke play, there is no penalty for moving a fellow competitor's ball in either of these circumstances and the ball must be replaced. Rule 18-4.



Question 4:

In match play, what is the penalty if a player accidentally moves or touches an opponent's ball while searching for it through the green?

Answer 4:

There is no penalty and the ball must be replaced. Rule 18-3a.

Question 5:

In match play, what is the penalty if, other than during search, a player causes an opponent's ball lying through the green to move, or touches it purposely?

Answer 5:

One stroke penalty for moving or touching the opponent's ball and the ball must be replaced. Rule 18-3b
