Ladies Section

Sunday 5th and Monday 6th May GAUTENG LADIES OPEN STROKEPLAY hosted at Johannesburg Country Club

36 holes were played on the Sunday (18 on Rocklands and 18 on Woodmead) and then a further 18 holes on the Monday (on Woodmead) making this a 54 hole tournament Danielle shot 75 73 80 which is a total of 228 and thus 12 over par. She came tie 8th overall and also won the net prize for both the first and the second days. Emily Jones shot 78 74 79 which is a total of 231 and 15 over par and finished tie 10th overall. A great performance by both girls.

Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th May CHAPMAN LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS



This tournament was played over two days – 18 holes per day.

On the first day Danielle broke the existing course record set by Claire Minter in 2011 – that record was 71 and Danielle broke it by two shooting a 69. Her second day was not as good perhaps too relaxed after her achievement of day one – nonetheless Danielle went on to win the Chapman Ladies Club Championships by a margin of 14 strokes over Loyce Chingono

Saturday 18th and Sunday 19th May JOHANNESBURG COUNTRY CLUB LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS





This tournament was played over two days – and on the two separate courses – so 18 holes on Rocklands on the Saturday and 18 holes on Woodmead on the Sunday.

This is Danielle's second year of membership but the first Club Champs that she has travelled to participate in.

The first day saw her shoot 78 to be 7 shots behind the leader (and several times past winner) Angie Thompson.

Determination shone through in Danielle's performance on the second and final day. Starting with a birdie on hole # 1 it became apparent she had catching up in the forefront of her mind. By the end of hole 12 Angie Thompson, Marine Legentill and Danielle Bekker were lying tie in the lead. All three parted the par 3 number 13. Danielle bogeys hole 14 and Marine birdies putting Danielle 2 shots back from the lead again. Number 15 is a par 3 – Danielle hit a beautiful shot off the tee to birdie that hole and Marine bogeyed – now they are back to level in the lead again. With her birdie Danielle goes first off the tee on hole number 16 which is a par 5 – and pulls her drive into the left fairway bunker – the other ladies all hit straight down the middle of the fairway. Sinking a 5 meter birdie putt gives Danielle a BIRDIE and the others got PARS so now we have an outright lead of 1 stroke going into 17. Everyone pars hole 17. Going into the par 5 hole number 18 this was nail biting stuff as Danielle led Marine by 1 stroke. Marine hit a great approach shot to the green setting up a birdie – and Danielle parred – hence resulting in both girls being on 152 for the two rounds (8 over for the two rounds) and thus the need for a playoff. Their tournament rules call for a sudden death play off where hole number 18 is played repeatedly. The first time both girls parred and so they went back down the hill again to play it a second time. This time Danielle did a fabulous approach shot to a meter from the pin where Marines shot flew to the back of the green.

Marine missed her birdie putt and got a par – Danielle sunk her birdie putt – and became the 2019 Lady Club Champ for Johannesburg Country Club – a club that was founded in 1906. As is tradition she delivered her winners speech shortly after receiving the trophy.

Looking forward both Danielle Bekker and Emily Jones have been selected to represent Mpumalanga in the WGSA 72 Holes Teams Championship being hosted at Maccauvlei Golf Club in Vereeniging from the 2nd to the 5th June 2019.

They then fly up immediately to Lusaka in Zambia to participate in the Zambian Ladies Open which is 7th ,8th and 9th June 2019.

We have purchased two Toro green mowers to improve the manicuringof our greens.

Please adhere to the following rules and regulations.

- We should be appropriately dressed while on the course, at the golf range, in the clubhouse or visiting the pro shop as noted in our club dress code.
- We should have a sand bag before play as the rule says NO SAND BAG NO PLAY.
- We should fill divots not fill cricket holes and repair pitch marks. A divot repaired within five minutes will be invisible within a day. If a pitch mark is left for a day it takes a month before it becomes invisible.
- We should avoid slow play as it spoils the game for all of us.
- Please we should not use cell phones on the golf course: we all know they annoy everyone.
- Please let's pay our caddies soon after playing to avoid them wondering around the club premises and also do not ask them to take your golf bag to the car park as you risk them being suspended from the club.
- Members are required to sign their visitors in the book at reception.
- Please if wearing golf shoes do not bring mud into the clubhouse.
- All players must make sure you register, pay and obtain a receipt before playing.
- Please let us not dump litter on the course it is our course so let's keep it clean.
